William served with the U.S. Navy during World War II as a Master Machine Mate aboard the USS Siboney. He also served 2 years in the National Guard. William was a police officer in St. Clair Shores for 26 years. He was a 55 years Mason at the Jefferson Lodge in St. Clair Shores and a combined 51 year Shriner with both the Moslem Temple, Detroit and Azan Temple, Florida. 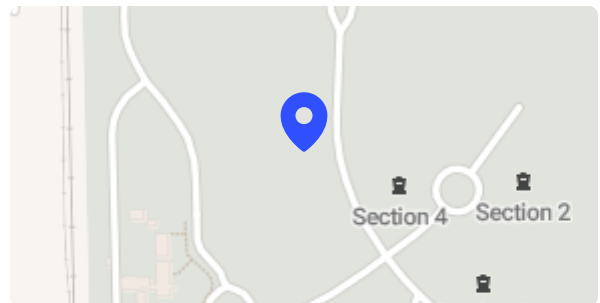

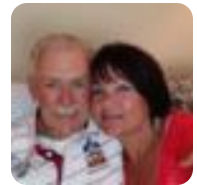
