Jerry also proudly served and retired from the United States Coast Guard Reserves after 30 years obtaining the rank of Chief Warrant Officer Four. He retired from the IRS- Appellate Division after 30 plus years of service. He enjoyed reading, traveling, long walks, and making rosaries with his wife.

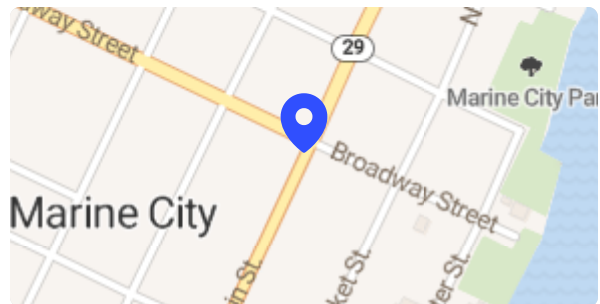

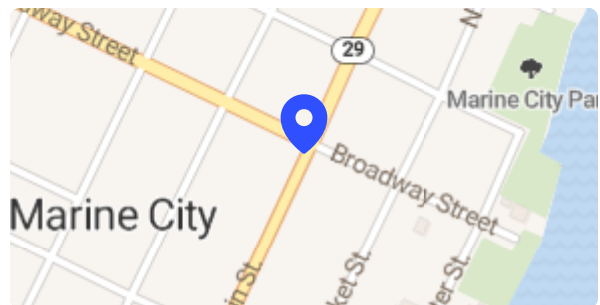

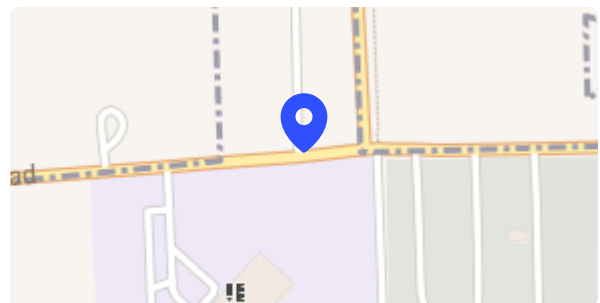
