**D**onald F. Smith, age 91, of St. Clair, died February 25, 2015. He was born July 25, 1923 in Windsor, Ontario. Donald married Velma Hytonene on April 14, 1945. He was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church for 54 years and Light of Christ Lutheran Church for the past 8 years. Donald served with the Canadian Armed Forces during World War II. 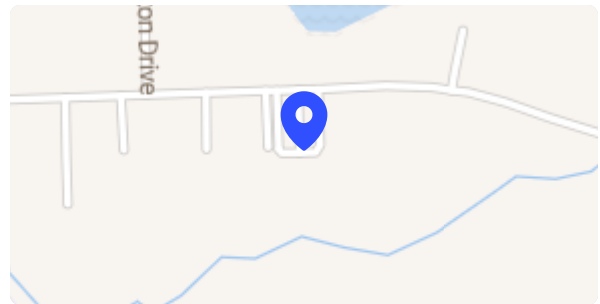

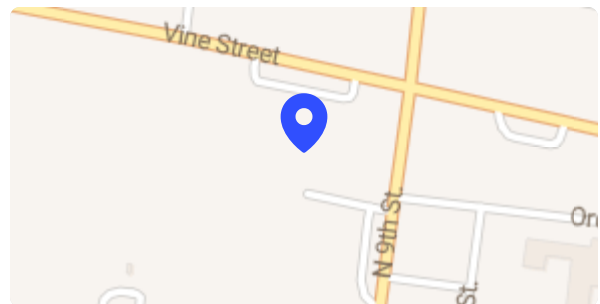

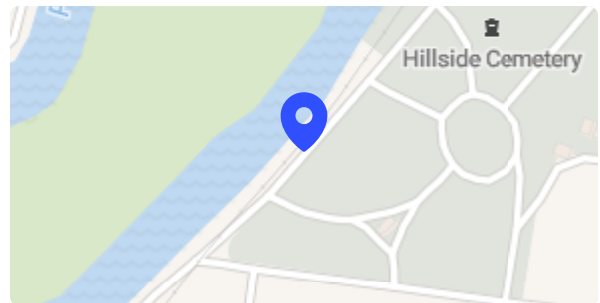
