On March 2, 2016 David B. Wood passed away unexpectedly at his home. A resident of Marine City for 37 years, David was born in Detroit on April 18, 1948 to the late Donald and Vivienne Wood. 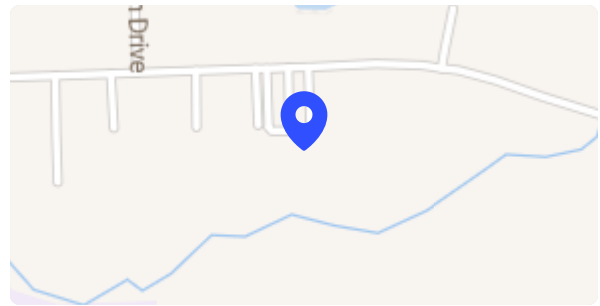

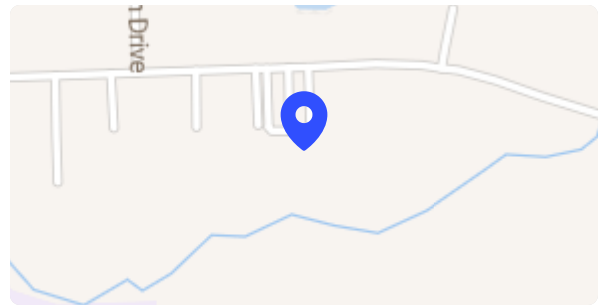
