**K**enneth N. Sayers, age 85, of China Twp., died April 1, 2016. He was born August 12, 1930 in St. Clair to the late Earl and Genevieve Sayers.

Kenny served his country honorably from 1946 to 1947 with the U.S. Army. On March 11, 1950 Kenny married Roma Endres. She preceded him in death in 2013. He was a union pipefitter for 40 years and a member of the Pipefitters Local 636. Kenny was also a member of the American Legion Post 382, St. Clair. 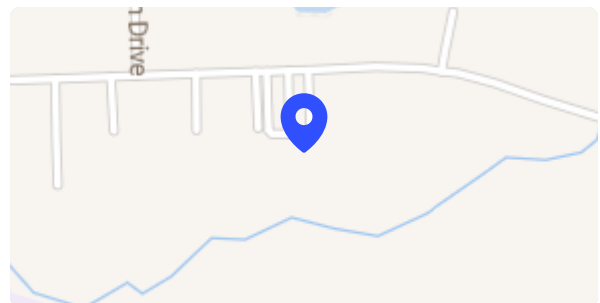

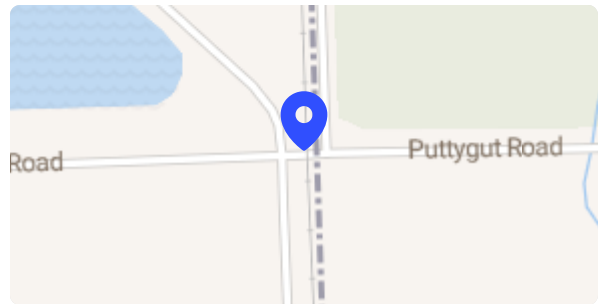
