Memorials may be made to St. Paul's Episcopal Church.

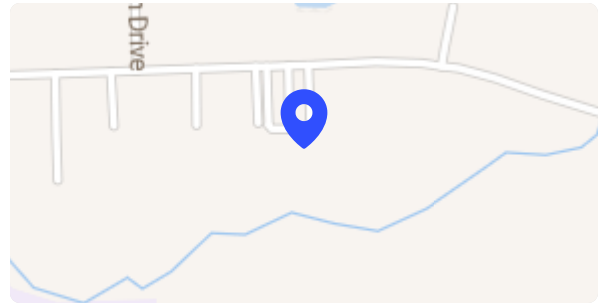

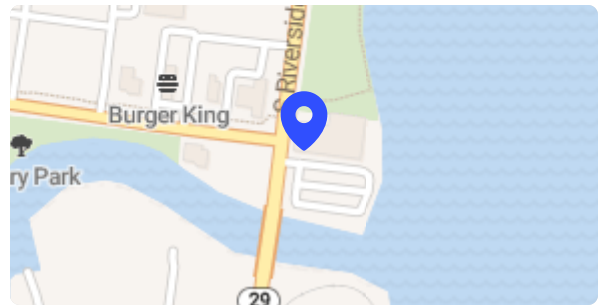
