Visiting hours are Thursday 2:00 to 4:00 and 6:00 to 8:00.

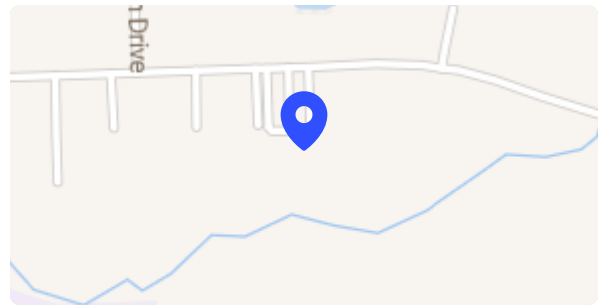

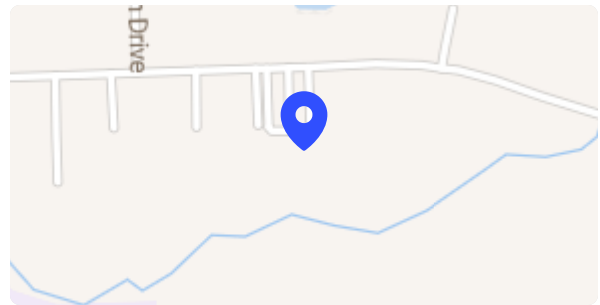

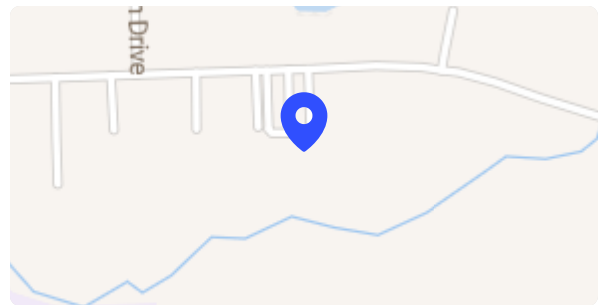
