Robert "Bob" Biewer, age 79, of St. Clair, died December 21, 2016. He was born May 31, 1937 in St. Clair to the late John and Hazel Biewer.

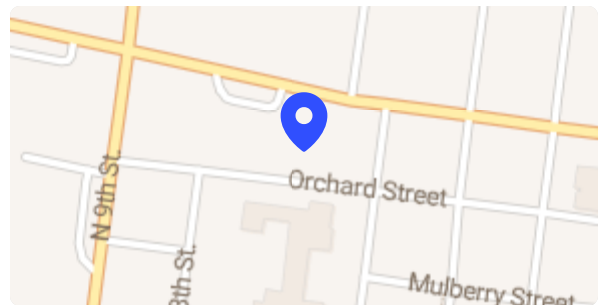

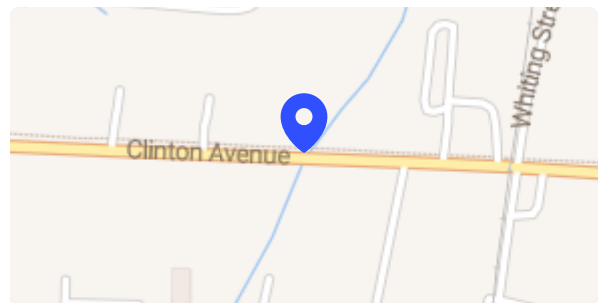
