Robert D. Frantz, age 83, of St. Clair Twp., went home to be with the Lord on April 2, 2017, with his loving family at his side. He was born September 22, 1933, to the late Lee and Mary Frantz in Huntington, Indiana. On October 11, 1958, Robert married Shirley Briggs in Grindstone City, Michigan.

Bob served with the U.S. Army from 1955 to 1957. He was a very gifted athlete. He received All American Honors in high school football and All State Honors in high school track. While in the service he competed in the Golden Gloves. Bob worked for 25 years with the St. Clair County Road Commission. He loved to fish and hunt and there wasn't anything he couldn't fix or repair.

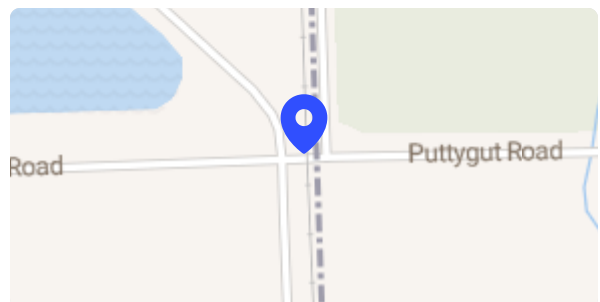
