Gilroy "Gil" O. Pavey, age 72, of Casco Twp., peacefully passed away on April 20, 2017, with his family at his side. He was born June 27, 1944 in Detroit to the late Gilroy and Emma Pavey.

On October 27, 1967 Gil married Betty May Uppleger. She preceded him in death on March 31, 1998. Gil proudly served with the U.S. Air Force during the Vietnam War and later worked for Inductoheat in Madison Heights for over 20 years.

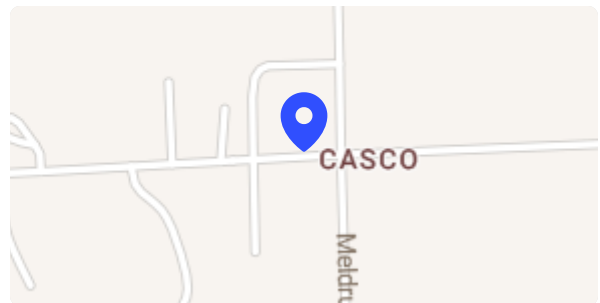

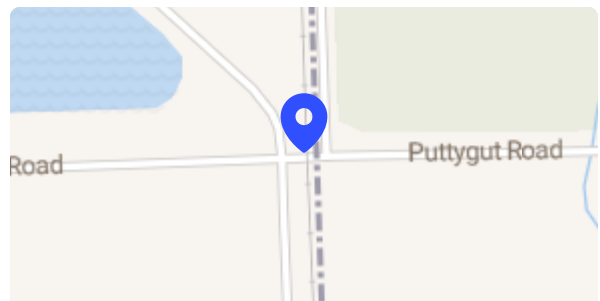
