Genevieve B. "Jenny" Street, age 93, of Marine City, passed away unexpectedly May 8, 2018. She was born July 3, 1924 in her home in Forest, Ontario to the late James and Agnes Hubbard. On July 7, 1945 Jenny married Walter M. Street also in Forest, Ontario. He preceded her in death in 2006.
