Sharon was born in St. Clair on January 1, 1950, the first child born in St. Clair in the 1950's. She is the daughter of Ervin "Biff" and Ruth (Krieg) LaBuhn. She was elected the first female Marine City High School President class of 1968. Sharon received her Associate Degree from St. Clair Junior College and her Bachelor Degree in Nursing from U of D Mercy. She began her 40 year career as a registered nurse in various capacities in New York, California and Michigan, working in ER, dermatology and geriatrics. On June 19, 1993 Sharon married Woody Flemming.

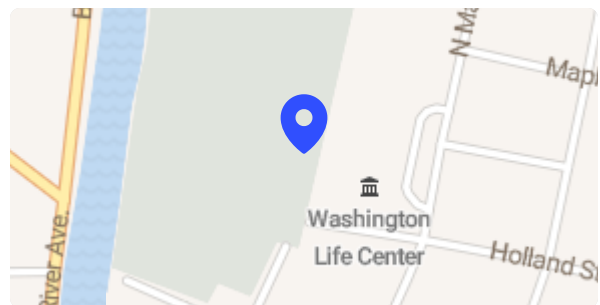
