He faithfully served his country with the U.S. Army in the 82nd Airborne during World War II.

He served in Normandy, Ardennes, Rhineland, Central Europe, Sicily and Naples-Foggia, earning EAME Theater Ribbons with 6 Bronze Stars.

He worked many years for Studebaker and then retired from Chrysler after 20 years of service.

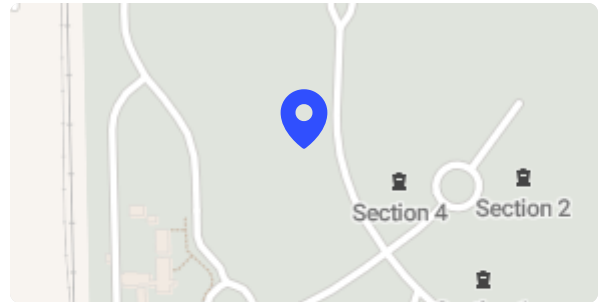

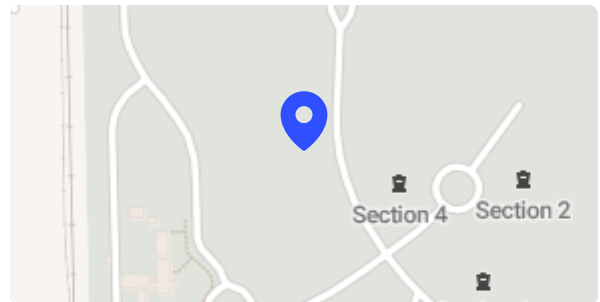
