Harry Francis “Pappy” Rybinski Jr., age 68 of St. Clair, passed away August 23, 2019. He was born May 17, 1951 in St. Clair to the late Harry Sr. and Alice Rybinski.

Harry loved music and played the blues with several area bands, most recently with Roadside Rick and the Breakdowns.

I remember visiting Harry and Becky at their house in St Clair. I'm so sorry he passed. My condolences to his family.



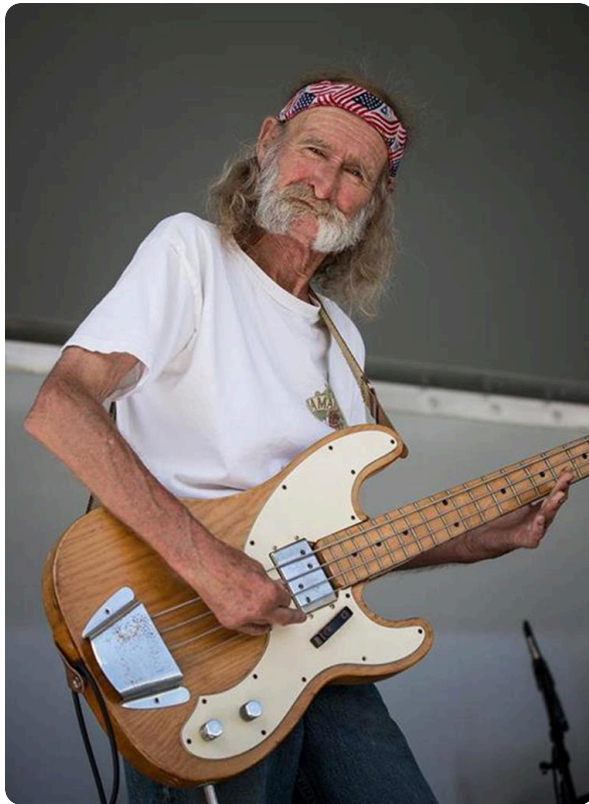

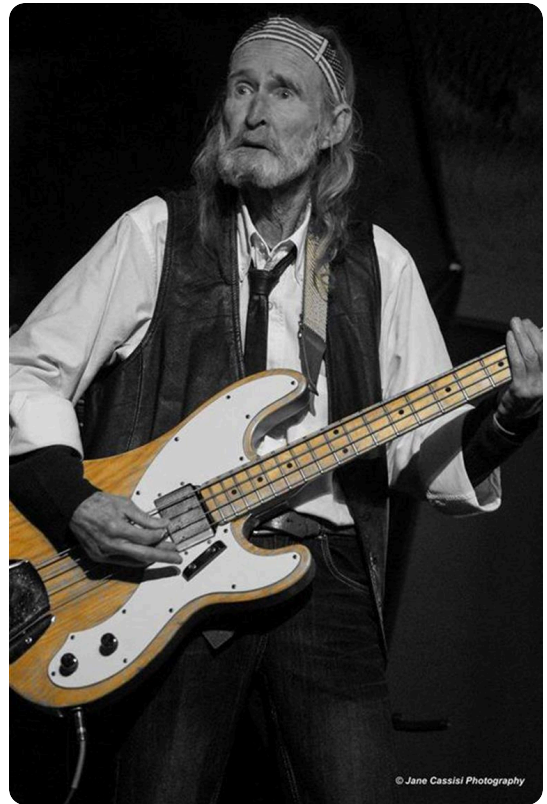
