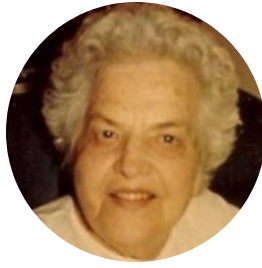

Pearle M. Allen, age 100, of St. Clair, was born July 9, 1912 near Harrisburg, Ohio. Her parents were Elnathen Paul and Addie Jane Morehouse. Pearle graduated from Bidwell High School in 1930 and attended Rio Grande Normal School for several years before starting her teaching career in several one room schools in Southern Ohio.

Pearle married Hollie R. Allen, June 23, 1935, and after many travels, finally settled in Bradley, IL in 1942. She continued her education at Olivet Nazarene College and at the University of Illinois, receiving her Masters Degree in Library Science in 1954. Pearle was involved in many activities, such as Camp Fire Girls, Girl Scouts, square dancing, reading, painting, photography, writing short stories and traveling all over the U.S. and Europe. She was also a member of the First United Methodist Church, St. Clair. She retired from teaching in 1974 and she and Hollie moved to St. Clair to be with their son, Richard, and his family.

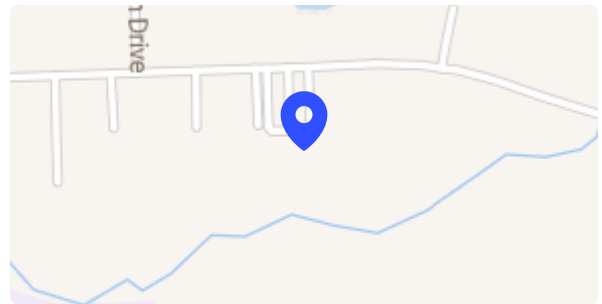

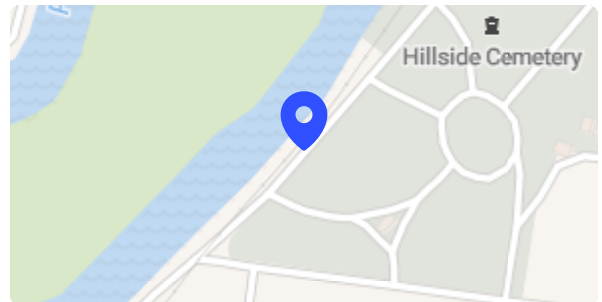

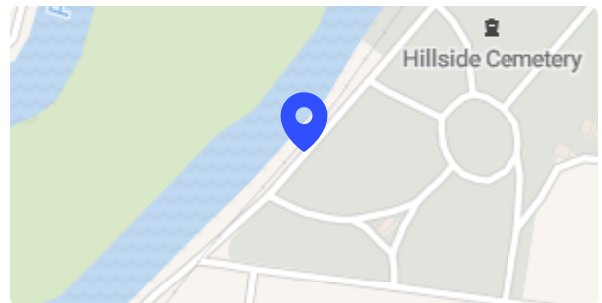
