Marie A Klemmer age 88 of St. Clair passed away May 2, 2020 following a long illness. She was born March 20, 1932 in St Clair to the late Herbert and Mable (Distelrath) Meyers.

Marie worked for many years as a lunch lady at Pine River Elementary school before working for several years at Hodges and Irvine. She was a member of the Daughters of Isabella at St. Mary's Catholic Church in St. Clair. She also belonged to a neighborhood Mothers Club for over 50 years enjoying lifelong friendships with the Mothers of children that attended the one room Carlton School on St. Clair Highway. She was a great fan of St Clair Little League, becoming one of the first female coaches. 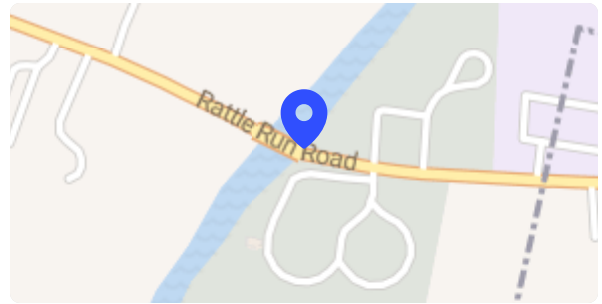

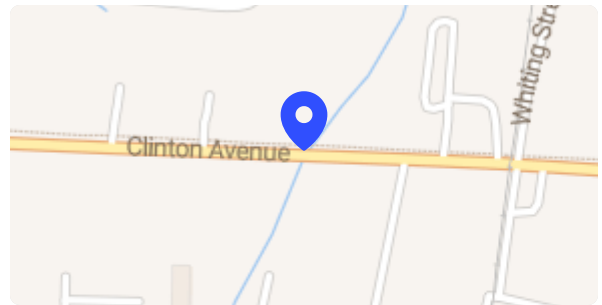
