Bob was employed as a truck driver for 36 years with the majority of those years driving for Express Freightline. He was also a proud member of Teamsters Local #299. Bob was an active member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Casco Twp. He formerly served on the China Twp. Planning Commission. He enjoyed duck carving, outdoor activities and spending time with his family.

He is survived by his sons, Randy (Andrea) Malone, Ron (Lana) Malone and Rodney (Dale) Malone; grandchildren, Nicci (Matt) LaDue, Dylan (Ericka) Malone, Conner and Logan Malone; great grandchildren, Owen and Aaron LaDue and Jaxon Malone and many nieces and nephews. 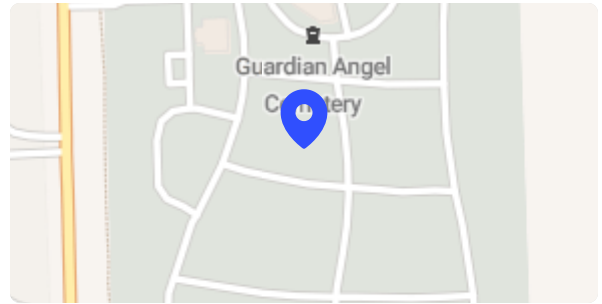

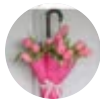

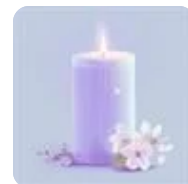
