Carl Albert Eisen, age 90, of St. Clair, passed away on December 9, 2020 following a long struggle with many health issues. Carl was born September 1, 1930 in China Twp. to the late Carl and Albertha Eisen.

Carl married Marlene Gramzow of St. Clair on August 3, 1957 at Immanuel Lutheran Church, St. Clair. She preceded him in death on September 2, 2019.

He graduated from St. Clair High School and served in the United States Marine Corps during the Korean War. He worked at the St. Clair Macomb Consumers CO-OP for 12 years and retired from Michigan Consolidated Gas Co. after 25 years of service.

Carl was a life long member of St. Peter's Lutheran Church in St. Clair where he was baptized and confirmed. 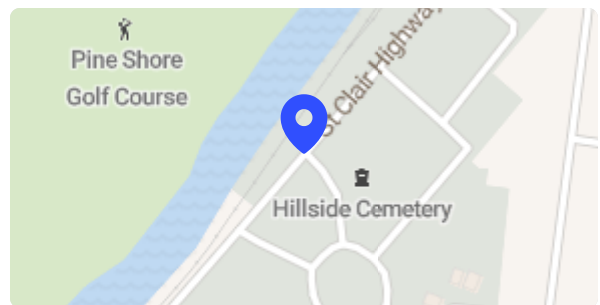
