MaryAnn Jeffery, age 59, of Casco, Michigan passed away December 11, 2020. She was born November 7, 1961 in Detroit to the late Harvey and Ann Jeffery. MaryAnn graduated from Marine City High School in 1979 and received her Bachelor of Science Degree in Graphics from Ferris State University in 1983. MaryAnn enjoyed a long career with General Motors. In 1985 she began her career as a Gun Welder at the Fleetwood Plant building Cadillac bodies in 1985. She later served as the Customer Relations Manager and Roadside Service Manager. Her final years of employment with GM she was a Dealer Business Manager and Product Training Manager. Her final position was with Delphi Corp. as a Customer Experience Manager.

On June 1, 1991 MaryAnn married Scott Pickelhaupt and they enjoyed 29 years of marriage. She loved her time traveling and spending time at her cottage in Northern Michigan with Scott and their many friends. MaryAnn had a very special place in her heart for dogs. She rescued and found homes for countless dogs and would even assist in getting proper treatment for those dogs in need. MaryAnn was also a courageous cancer survivor.

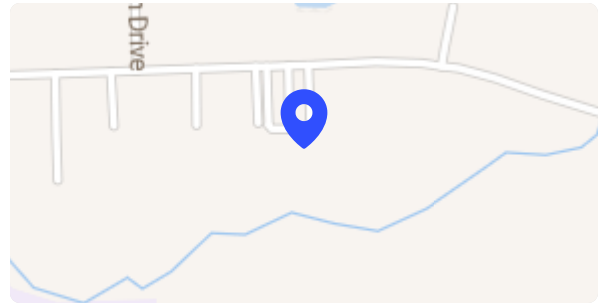

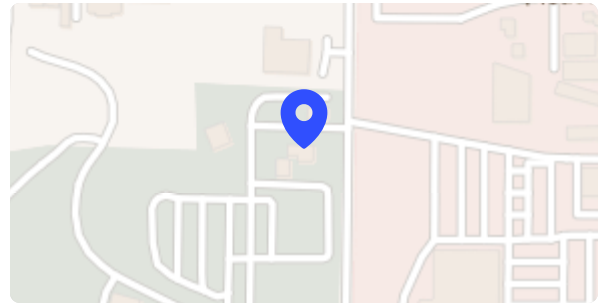
