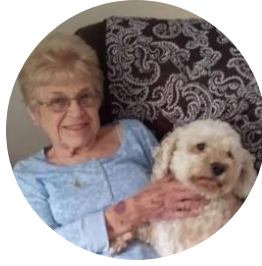

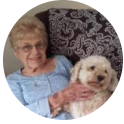
MAY 28, 1939 - APR 3, 2021

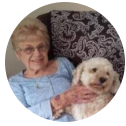

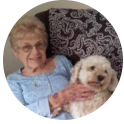
