## Leslie R. "Les" Osterland

**L**eslie R. "Les" Osterland, age 91, of Richmond, passed away November 1, 2021. He was born January 10, 1930 in China Twp. to the late William and Alice Osterland.

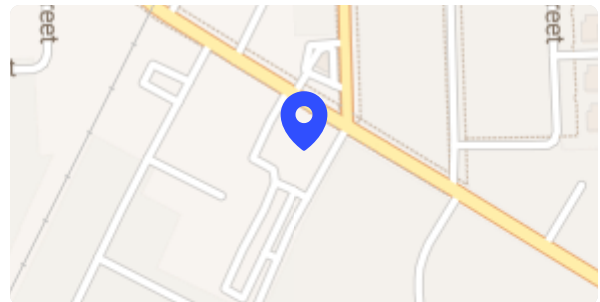

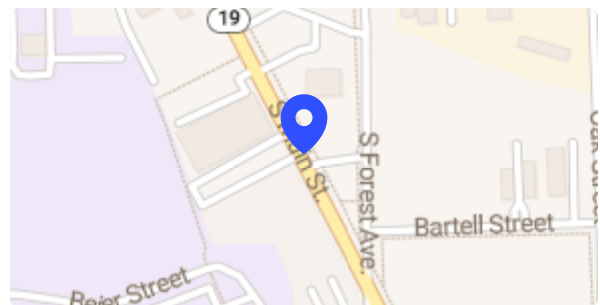
