**A**aron B. Lipke, age 70, of East China, passed away December 15, 2021 after a courageous battle with pancreatic cancer. He was born January 20, 1951 in St. Clair to the late Bernard and Myrtice Lipke. He married Karrie Emig on July 17, 1971.

Aaron worked for the City of Marysville Water Department for many years and retired in 2002. Upon retirement he and Karrie moved to Sun City West, Arizona and enjoyed 16 years of retired life there. They moved back to East China in 2020 to be close to their kids and grandkids.

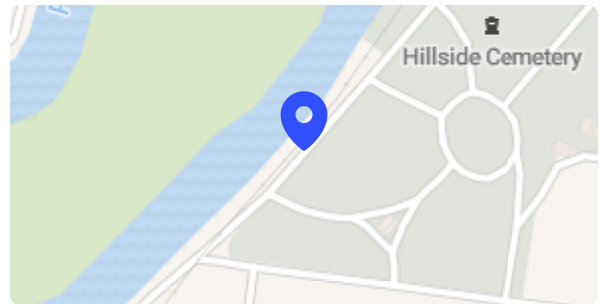
