Matthew Steven Lemon, age 70, of East China Twp, formerly Peru, IN, passed away August 5,

2023 after a lifelong battle with Cystic Fibrosis and a more recent diagnosis of esophageal

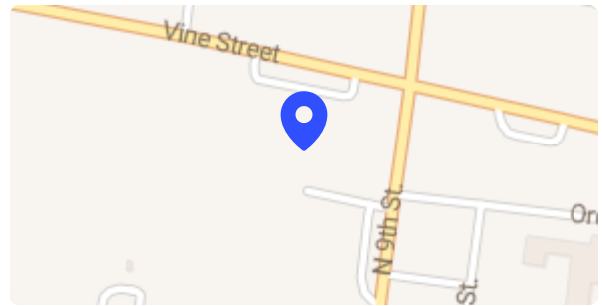

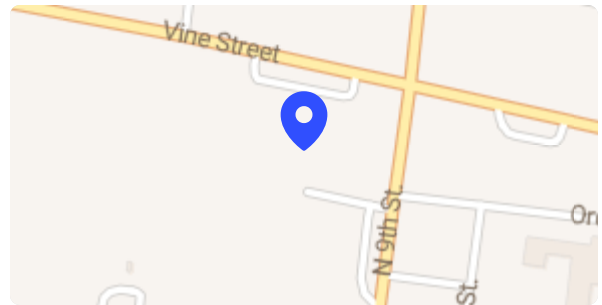
