Lawrence "Larry" Biscorner died Saturday, November 4, 2023 surrounded by his family after a short, courageous battle with cancer. He was born on December 2, 1948 to Ralph and Loretta Biscorner. Larry was a proud veteran of the United States Army. He spent his career working for the Ford Motor Company where he retired after 30 years of service. He later served in different capacities and positions including working for the DNR boat launch in Marine City. He enjoyed being outside, fishing and hunting with his family and friends, especially his son Ryan.

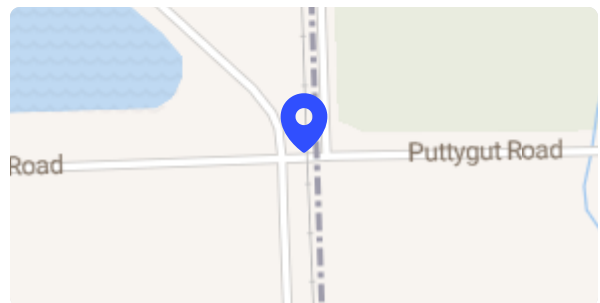

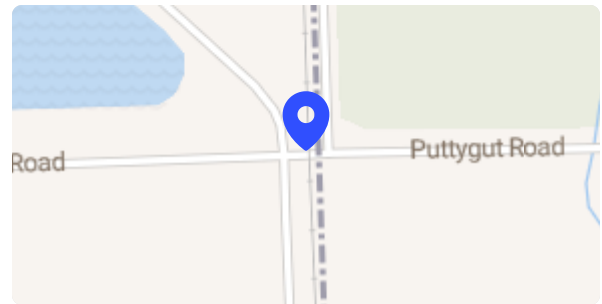
