At the age of 9 Butch moved to St. Clair, where he later graduated from St. Clair High School with the Class of 1956. His education continued at St. Clair Junior College, where he received his associates degree.

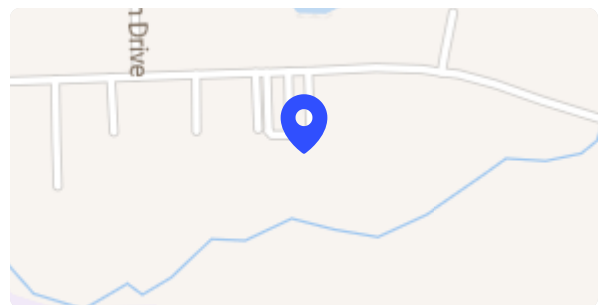

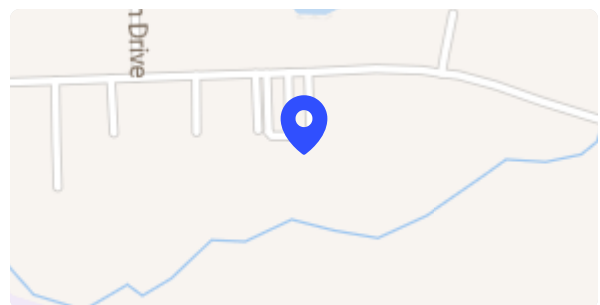

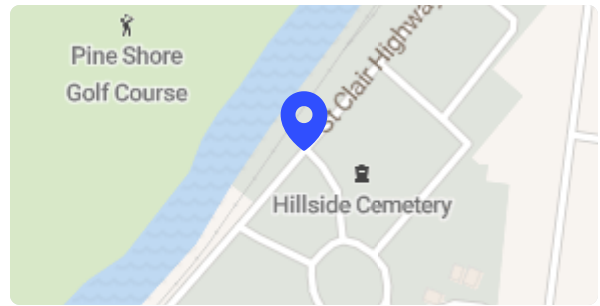
