Bernard "Bernie" Vandebossche, age 82, of China Twp., passed away August 19, 2024. Bernie was born September 3, 1941 in Mt. Clemens to the late Daniel and Mary Vandebossche. On February 7, 1970 Bernie married Audrey Warren in Port Huron.

Bernie proudly served his country with the U.S. Army, as did each of his brothers. For 31 years Bernie was Assistant Superintendent at Maple Lane Golf Course in Sterling Heights, retiring in 1997. He was also co-owner of Vandebossche Farms in China Twp. Bernie was a hard working man that took great pride in what he did. 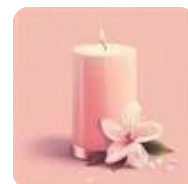
