James William Chopp, age 87, of Marine City, passed away November 8, 2024 with his loved ones by his side.

James received his PhD in Educational Administration and enjoyed a 50 year career in education. James retired as principal and later served as interim superintendent for many local school districts. 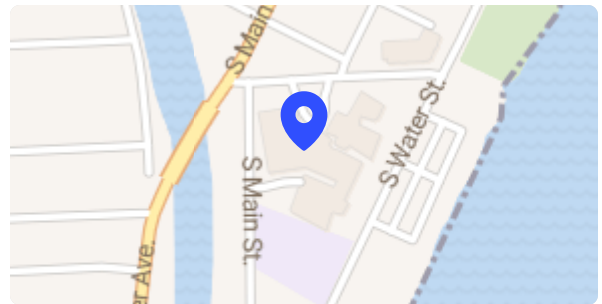

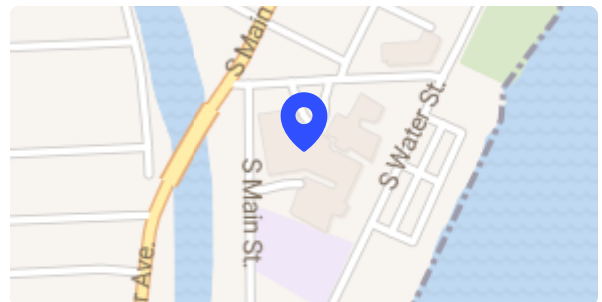

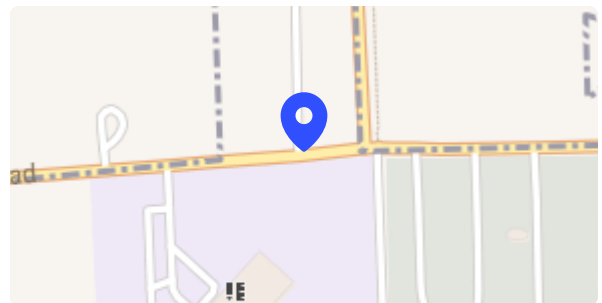
