**O**n August 6, 2025, Thomas Edward McLeod age 80 of St. Clair, Mi passed away in the home he built surrounded by the family he created. Tom was born in Detroit, Mi. on January 6, 1945, to the late Donald and Henreitta McLeod.

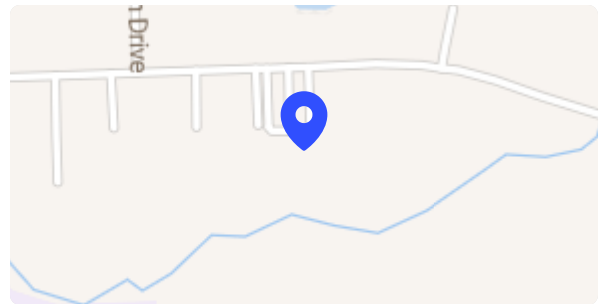

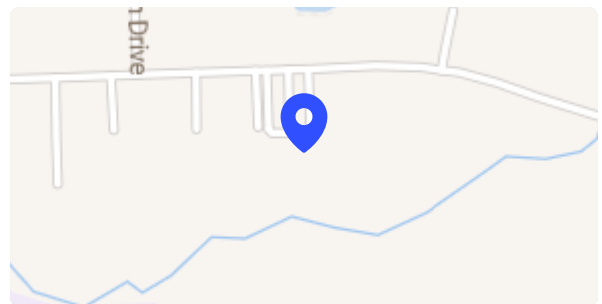

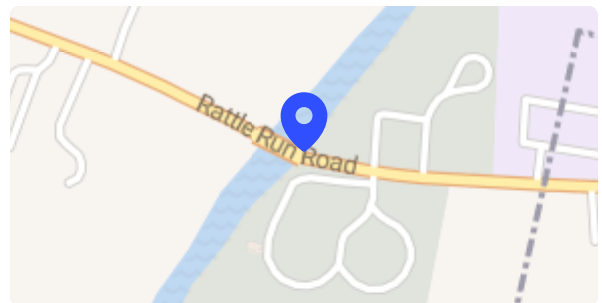
