Michael Charles Debano Jr., age 59, of China Township, passed away December 1, 2025, following a long courageous battle with cancer. He was born May 7, 1966 in Mt. Clemens to Michael Sr. and Marie Debano.

On May 19, 1989 Michael married Sharon Beier in St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Casco Twp. He proudly served his country from 1984 to 1990 with the U.S. Navy and Naval Reserves. Michael also was a 10 year employee for St. Clair County. He was an active charter member of the Marysville Knights of Columbus Council 9526.
